F15/15 GRANT APPLICATION- WYMONDHAM DEMENTIA SUPPORT GROUP. Upon the resolution of Cllr. Gibbins and seconded by Cllr. Heard it was unanimously resolved to award a grant of £406.88 for the purchase of gardening equipment.

F16/15 GRANT APPLICAIION – WYMONDHAM HIGH ACADEMY Upon the resolution of Cllr. Gibbins and seconded by Cllr. Savage it was unanimously resolved to award a grant of £500.00 towards the cost of staging a Medieval Pageant.

F17/15 GRANT APPLICATION – WYMONDHAM YOUTH BUS Upon the resolution of Cllr. Gibbins and seconded by Cllr. Broome it was unanimously resolved to award a grant of £771.52 towards the purchase of a battery jump starter and equipment.

F18/15 GRANT APPLICATION – LIGHT UP WYMONDHAM Application for grant towards the purchase and installation of Christmas Lights was discussed and it was agreed that the Council would consider a further application if more information is provided :

- Status within the Wymondham Business Group and confirmation of any amount they are providing.
- More details of the work proposed, as the quotation provided is vague.
- The quotation refers to ‘additional requirement would be the electric supply wiring and RCD switching from the individual supplier’ – what is the cost of this work.
- The outcome of other funding applications.
- If successful this year how would future years be funded.

F19/15 CEMETERY FEES Comparative figures for other local Councils were noted and to be used by the Committee when it next reviews the Council’s fees.
