Cllr. Hornby suspended Standing Orders to allow Councillors not on the Committee who were present to participate in the discussion.

Cllr. Hurn outlined the paper he had prepared which is attached to these minutes and asked the committee to support the proposals .There was general support for the proposals and discussion that the following be considered:

Following re-instatement of standing orders the Committee resolved to approve the recommendations in the report.

LE36/15 BUDGET 2016/17 Cllr. L Hornby presented the draft for discussion and submission to the Finance & General Purposes Committee for incorporation into the Council budget for the 2016/17 financial year. The Clerk explained that this might be subject to some minor amendments as the Council would not receive the final information from South Norfolk Council until December which is required to complete the budget setting process. After discussion and clarification upon the resolution of Cllr. Osborne and seconded by Cllr. Underwood it was unanimously resolved to recommend a budget of £158,031.00 to the Finance & General Purposes Committee.
