LE41/11 MINUTES OF MEETING Upon the proposition of Cllr. Astley & seconded by Cllr. Wright it was resolved to accept the minutes of the meeting held on 20th September 2011 as a true record.

LE43/11 BROWICK ROAD FOOTPATH - UPDATE BY THE CLERK

Clerk reported that the path surface has been installed and that as far as she knew the rails had been done.

LE44/11 KETTS PARK CHANGING ROOMS – UPDATE BY THE CLERK

Clerk reported that work was complete and it was now being used.

LE45/11 Upon a proposition of Cllr Roberts & Seconded by Cllr Turner it was agreed under the provisions of Section 1 of the public Bodies (Admission to meetings) Act 1960 to exclude Press and Public from the meeting of Wymondham Town Council in order to discuss matters where publicity would be prejudicial to the public interest by reason of the confidential nature of the business to be transacted.

LE46/11 BUDGET 2012/13 –

Cllr Savage explained the budget and made it clear that this committee would need to think about what other bodies will be doing.

Cllr Turner said we had to be careful with public money in both directions, don't stop everything but not to increase too much Cllr Turner was broadly happy..

Cllr Astley suggested if we shuffled things around we could keep L & E increase to 0% Cllr Roberts agreed. Cllr Turner agreed but also added not to reduce the budget.

Recommendations:

Cllr Astley proposed to shuffle things about to make the global L & E Budget a 0% increase. Cllr Roberts seconded.

All agreed to accept subject to contributing to an overall increase of 0% but not to be less than last year, as not prepared to see a decrease that would affect what we provide.

Cllr Roberts added- Open Space budget could possibly be cut if needed, we could cut out the reserves for open spaces but only for this year.
