

Catholic Church

After the Reformation and the destruction of the Abbey, which left only the Abbey Church, stripped of its former glory, practice of the Roman Catholic faith stopped in Wymondham until the very end of the 19th Century.



The Catholic church of Our Lady & St Thomas of Canterbury is a memorial church built in 1952 to be a permanent memorial to those who suffered as prisoners of war and internees of the Japanese during World War II.



The memorial is known as the Far East Prisoners Of War memorial (FEPOW).
